APS CENTRAL PHOENIX LINE UPGRADE PROJECT

APS plans to upgrade a critical underground transmission line in central Phoenix - the "backbone" of the metro Phoenix 230kV transmission system. This project supports reliability for customers by replacing a line that is reaching the end of its design life and supports growing energy needs by expanding the capacity of the line. Work is scheduled October 2023 through April 2024.

To remove and replace the underground line, APS's contractor, Ferreira UTEC, will access manholes at various locations along the project route. In some instances, this will require large equipment near the manhole site to remove existing cable, run a robotic device through the pipeline to evaluate its integrity, and install new cable.

9th Street, south of Fillmore Street

- Manholes on 9th Street, between Fillmore Street and Taylor Street, will need to be accessed starting in early October 2023 through April 2024.
- Work at the manholes will not be continuous. The contractor will need access to the manholes at various points in the schedule.
- 9th Street will be limited to one direction of travel only at certain times during the project. Detour signage will be in place to direct travelers around the work area.
- Approximately one week prior to any road closure, message boards will be placed in the neighborhood and include closure dates.
